
## Last three years' averages






### Timeline for EC-6 & 4-8 Candidates (for now)




## Timeline for EC-6 & 4-8 Candidates (for later)



## Timeline Secondary & All-level Candidates (for now)







#### How we enforce

Our grading scale: 93-100 A; 83-92 B; 75-82 C; 65-74 D; <65 F.

\*\* A passing score on the ETBU practice exam (80%) is worth 30% of the final grade in Field Based Experience courses.\*\*

NOTE: PPR, EC-6 Core Subjects, and 4-8 content tests only!

#### Interventions

- PPR (spreadsheet with resources by competency); Content (review GL textbooks) <u>Example</u>
- Student reviews feedback by competency, coding areas of: Strength (80-100%), Caution (65-79%), and Concern (Below 65%)
- Students review the Competencies and Descriptive Statements, highlighting terms that are unfamiliar in context (redirect them to Preparation Manuals); Study.com (site license)
- Students MUST document study time (date/time/resources/what they studied) and have a
   MINIMUM of 6 hours of approved study before retesting (practice exam) will be considered
- Interactive Practice Exams
